Trends are easier to visualize in graph form

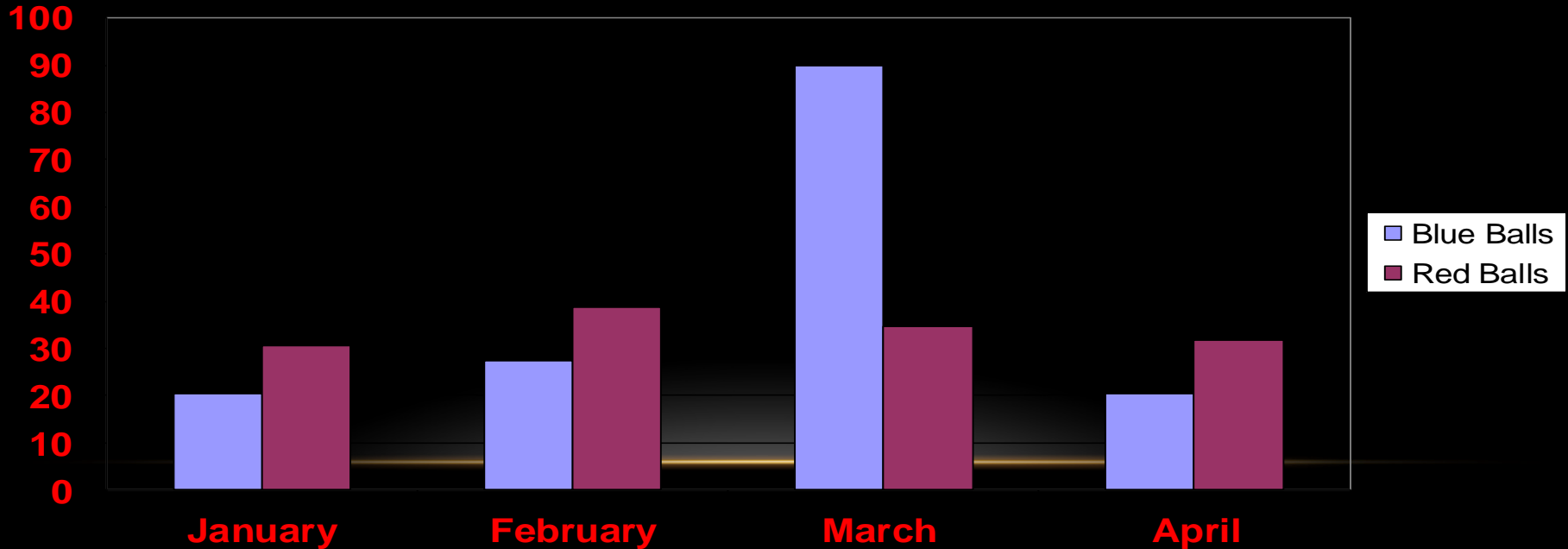
Always title your graphs

GRAPHS - BAD

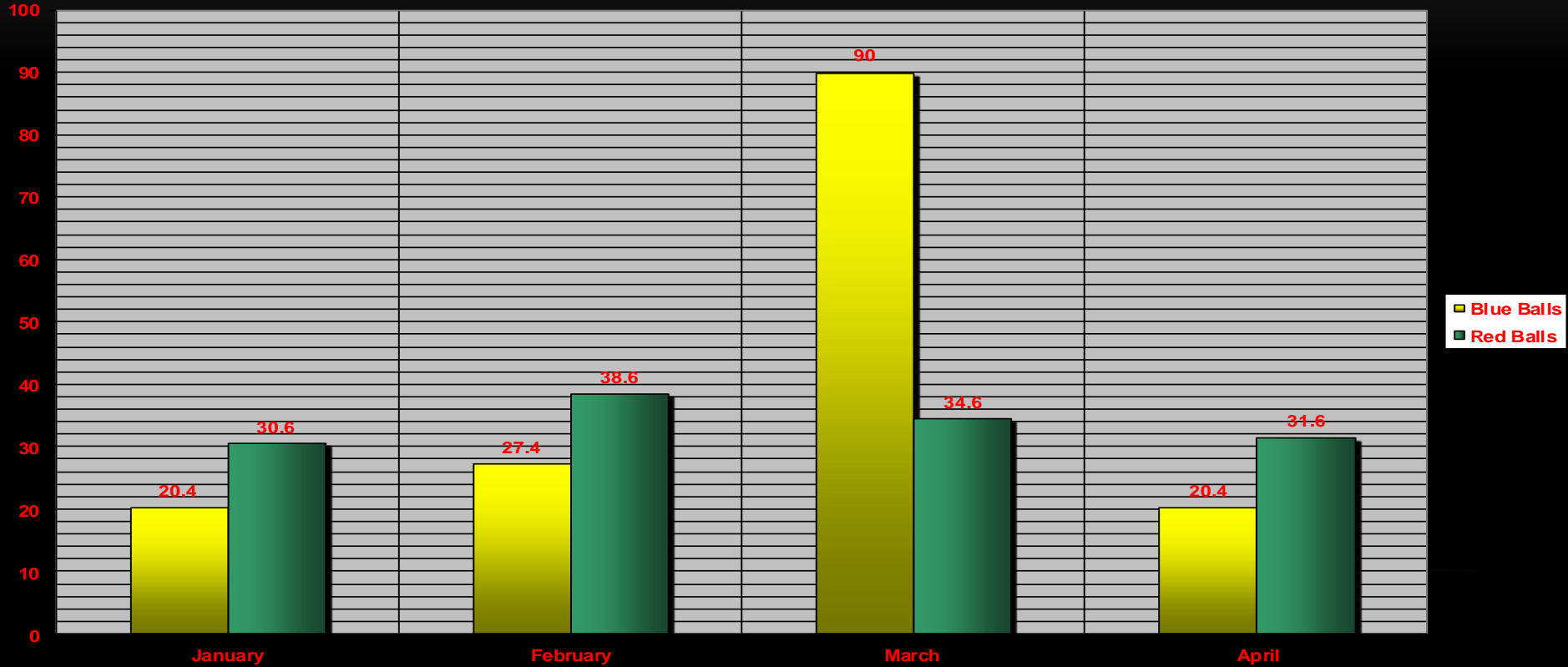
